

ANSI Value Character Chart - In the table mark all but the first row and the column to the left and choose font! Here Greek Old Face.

You will get the signs below in choosen font if - having activated Num Lock - you simultaneously press the ALT-key and on the numeric part of the keyboard enter 0 followed by two or usually three numbers shown in the table. Examples: ALT + 0139 = $\hat{\imath}$, ALT + 0203 = $\hat{\eta}$.

¹ *sampi* - one of three special numeral characters = 900; normally the letters are used as signs for numbers; up to 999 they are marked at the right hand top with $\acute{}$ (the \backslash -key); from 1000 onwards numbers are written with , (ALT + 0255) down in the lower part to the left; $\alpha' = 1$, $\beta' = 2$, $\gamma\alpha' = 3001$. Arabic numbers (1, 2, 3 ...) are used only in later texts.

² *digamma* - representing a sound [w] in some dialects, lost in Attic-Jonian.

³ *stigma* numeral character = 6; probably an old sign for Ϻ which is, in other alphabets, the sixth letter *f*; used in some older printings for $\sigma\tau$ [st].

⁴ alternative for *koppa* - see next note!

⁵ *koppa* (cfr *q* in the Latin alphabet) only used as numeral = 90

⁶ final *sigma* (not to be confounded with *stigma* - see note 6) never used as numeral, the "normal" *sigma* $\sigma' = 200$

⁷ *iota subscriptum* - a mute *i* written under a long vowel in lower case

⁸ Only representing characters in inscriptions written with the older (pre-Milesian) alphabet
